### RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the RRS 2009-2012.
- 1.2 Extreme 40 class rules will apply. 1.3 Addendum Q ( rules for umpired fleet race) will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

### 2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority in accordance with 20.4 ISAF regulations.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Extreme 40 class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by e-mail, together with the required fee to: [info@oceanracingclub.com](mailto:info@oceanracingclub.com) . Please include Team name, Team sponsor and Skipper's name.
- 3.4 The regatta is restricted to 15 boats.

## 7 SCHEDULE

7.1 Registration: From 11th July 12pm

7.2 Measurement and Inspection: From 12th July 10am until 13th July 6pm

7.3 Dates of racing:

7.4 Number of races:

There shall be a min of 6 races for a valid series.

7.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 10 am.

## 8 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall be presented for measurement in a complete ready to race form. Boats may be spot checked during the regatta.

## 9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

## 10 VENUE

10.1 The Container / Rigging and launch area will be at Marina Portoroz. 10.2 The Race office will be at The Ocean Racing Club, Kempinski Palace Hotel. 10.3 The racing area will be in the bay of Portoroz.

## 11 THE COURSES

11.1 The courses to be sailed will be Windward / Leeward Olympic style. There will be a skippers briefing /breakfast in the Kempinski Palace Hotel each day at 8.30am.

11.2 There will be one coastal race weather permitting.

## 12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 Penalties will be in accordance with Addendum Q and may be modified by the SI's. 12.2 Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.



### 13 SCORING

13.1 The scoring system is as follows: First place will be awarded the total fleet size e.g., 20 boat fleet 1st = 20points

2nd= 19 points

3rd= 18 points and so on

DNF, DSQ, DNS, = 0 points

13.2 The coastal race shall be scored double points.

13.3 6 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.4 The boat with the highest score at the end of the series shall be the winner.

### 14 SUPPORT BOATS

Each boat shall have a support RIB capable of righting the Extreme 40.

### 15 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park/rigging area and on the official regatta dock.

### 16 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Shall not be permitted during the regatta except when emergency repairs are required. The Measurer or Event organiser will decide if a boat can be hauled out.

### 17 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Each boat is allowed to carry a hand held radio for communication with the Race Committee and Event Organisers only. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions to anyone else while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

### 18 PRIZES

18.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 boats.

18.2 The overall winner will be awarded the Perpetual World Champion Title trophy.

### 19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### 20 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum of 3 million Euros or the equivalent.
